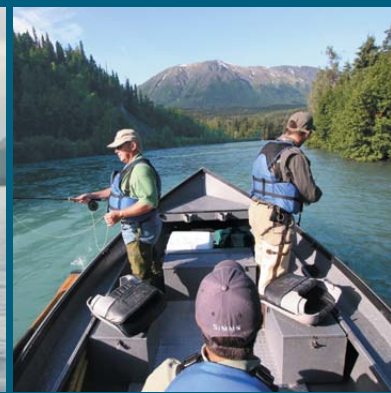

OF THE FIVE PACIFIC SALMON
SPECIES: KINGS, SOCKEYES,
SILVERS AND PINKS.

Discover for yourself why the Kenai River enjoys a worldwide reputation for its June and July runs of salmon, producing more trophy-sized king salmon than any other river in the world. An annual run of over 500,000 sockeye migrate through the river. In addition, August and September hold some of the most hard-fighting silver salmon, wild rainbow trout and exciting Dolly Varden fishing found anywhere.



THE KENAI PENINSULA IS LOCATED
TWO HOURS FROM ANCHORAGE.

The Kenai River stretches 82 miles, from Kenai Lake to Cook Inlet and includes Upper, Middle and Lower river sections. The Upper Kenai includes 16 miles of Alaska's most productive sockeye salmon, silver salmon, rainbow trout and Dolly Varden fishing waters. Our Kenai River Sportfishing Lodge is nestled here, surrounded by dramatic mountaintops and subtle callings of wildlife and birds.

A few miles downstream, a section known as the Lower Kenai flows over 50 miles from Skilak Lake to Cook Inlet and produces some of Alaska's finest king and silver salmon fishing.

When in season, we'll also troll for silvers in Resurrection Bay. Those in search of more adventure can fish for halibut off the coast. This exciting trip is included in our six day and seven day packages and can be added to shorter packages for an additional cost. Because of our ideal location in the heart of the Kenai Peninsula, you can experience a surprising variety of great fishing opportunities during your stay with us.

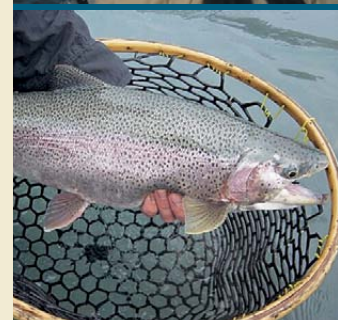
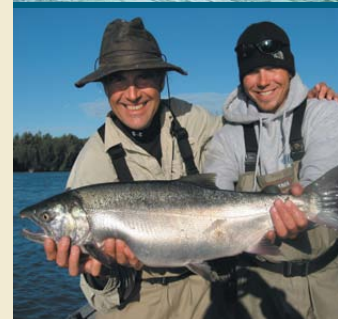
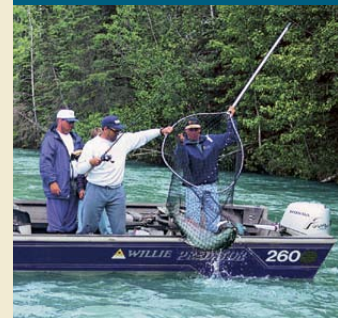
FLY FISHING AT ITS BEST: MONSTER RAINBOWS, DOLLIES AND SILVERS!

As our guides and returning guests know, there is no greater thrill than the chance to catch a huge rainbow trout, Dolly or silver on the fly while they voraciously feed in late August and September. Although we enjoy fly fishing throughout the summer, the late season provides beautiful colors and unparalleled fly fishing opportunities.

The non-motorized upper stretch of the Kenai River, between Kenai and Skilak Lakes, is home to the largest rainbows and has been designated by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game as a trophy rainbow zone. Reward yourself with an opportunity to catch rainbows up to 15 pounds, with many in the 16 to 22 inch range. We feature fishing in the remote Kenai Canyon and the stretch of river below the canyon when conditions are optimal.

FISHING AND NON-FISHING OPTIONS. For more fishing excitement, consider adding a "hike-in" fishing trip to your week. Many guests choose non-fishing options as well, join a guided hike or scenic Kenai River raft trip. Or complement your fishing vacation with a stay at Kenai Fjords Glacier Lodge, our exclusive seacoast destination situated within Kenai Fjords National Park. Call for details and we'll talk over your ideas for a customized trip.

GROUP AND EXCLUSIVE TRIPS. We specialize in arrangements for groups of all kinds, from corporate retreats to family reunions. We'll help you plan and coordinate your trip. THE BOATS.

DRIFT BOATS. Many anglers consider drift boats to be the ultimate river craft. We feature 18-foot models custom-designed for the Kenai River that fish up to four anglers. These boats are the best for accessing the “drift-only” waters of the Upper Kenai.

POWER BOATS. We fish from 20-foot wide-bottom Willie Predator river boats on the Lower Kenai River. Each boat comfortably accommodates four anglers.

IT’S A VACATION, AFTER ALL.

Our newly renovated lodge is the perfect place to enjoy a fine meal and trade stories at the day’s end. Enjoy hearty home cooking with a gourmet flair in our dining room, and relax with a bottle of Alaska micro brew or a glass of wine in our lounge. All meals and snacks are provided during your stay with us.

After dinner, take a sauna, fish from shore, stroll along our self-guided nature trail or relax in the lodge. At night, hang your hat in your cozy cabin located a short distance from the river’s edge.

SAMPLE ALL-INCLUSIVE FISHING LODGE PACKAGES.

Kenai River Sportfishing Lodge operates June 8 –September 22.

Two to seven day packages are available.

6 DAY/7 NIGHT SALMON/TROUT/HALIBUT.

For those with the time to experience the best of Alaska fishing, we recommend this package. You’ll have opportunities to fish for the available species of salmon plus rainbow trout and Dolly Varden. In addition to the abundance of freshwater fishing opportunities, you’ll join a charter vessel for a day trip into Alaska’s productive marine waters in search of huge Pacific halibut. This package includes six days of fishing.

5 DAY/6 NIGHT SALMON/TROUT. This package has been our most popular for years. You’ll chase kings or silvers on the Lower Kenai and float the Upper Kenai for rainbow trout and Dolly Varden—or possibly the prized sockeye salmon when in season. No matter what season you choose, we’ll maximize your fishing to make the most of your stay with us. This package includes five days of fishing.

3 DAY/4 NIGHT SALMON/TROUT. If you are short on time but want world-class Alaskan fishing, our shorter packages are perfect. Many travelers find these packages to be a great addition to a prearranged vacation. Enjoy the same amenities and fishing opportunities found in our longer packages. This package includes three days of fishing.

WHAT TO EXPECT NO MATTER WHAT PACKAGE YOU CHOOSE.

The day of your arrival, you'll depart Anchorage between 2-3 p.m. on a scenic drive to Kenai River Sportfishing Lodge in Cooper Landing. Enjoy dinner in the lodge. Later in the evening, retire to your comfortable cabin and rest up for some great fishing action. For the next two to seven days (depending on your package) fish up to eight hours per day with our experienced and friendly guides on the Kenai River and in Resurrection Bay. Your fishing options will be scheduled in advance of your visit. After breakfast on the day of your departure, keep an eye out for wildlife as you enjoy a scenic drive to the Anchorage Airport, arriving by noon.

All packages include: afternoon pick-up in Anchorage and noon drop-off in Anchorage, accommodations, meals, fishing instruction, top-quality gear including the best producing baits, lures and flies, transportation to and from launch sites, fish processing, vacuum packing and boxing. Packages do not include: fish licenses, beer, wine or liquor, gratuities to staff or cost of shipping fish.

WHAT YOU'LL CATCH AND WHEN YOU'LL CATCH THEM.



CHINOOK (KING) SALMON

AVG. SIZE: 40 LBS.

AVAILABLE: MAY-JULY

PEAK TIME: JULY

It's not unusual for our guests to catch a 40 to 60 pounder (the world record of 97 pounds was caught on the Kenai River in 1985). Take your turn at this once-in-a-lifetime fishing experience.



COHO (SILVER) SALMON

AVG. SIZE: 12 LBS.

AVAILABLE: AUGUST-SEPTEMBER

PEAK TIME: AUGUST

These hard-fighting fish can be caught on the Kenai or in Resurrection Bay.



SOCKEYE (RED) SALMON

AVG. SIZE: 8 LBS.

AVAILABLE: JUNE-AUGUST

PEAK TIME: JUNE-JULY

This species offers frequent hookups and fast action on light tackle. Our guests enjoy taking these delicious-tasting salmon home with them for good eating!



RAINBOW TROUT

AVG. SIZE: 20 INCHES

AVAILABLE: ALL SEASON

PEAK TIME: SEPTEMBER

The Kenai River is home to some of the largest native rainbow trout in Alaska. The excitement of hooking one of these prized fish is worth the trip to Alaska in itself. Our permits and experience allow us to fish limited access areas of the river.



DOLLY VARDEN (CHAR)

AVG. SIZE: 20 INCHES

AVAILABLE: ALL SEASON

PEAK TIME: SEPTEMBER

Along with trout, the Kenai is home to a large population of Dollies. These fish make the Upper Kenai a fly or spin fisherman's paradise.

STUNNING SUNRISE ON THE KENAI RIVER

RESERVATIONS. Reserve your space as soon as possible to secure the trip date most desired. Reservations can be made by phone and will be confirmed upon receipt of the required deposit. We accept checks, MasterCard, Visa and Discover.

At 120 days	50% of total
At 60 days	Final payment due
Within 60 days	100% of total

Reservations made within 60 days of departure must be “guaranteed” with MasterCard, Visa or Discover. Late payments may result in releasing your reservation and rebooking is subject to availability. Cancellation fees apply. Upon receipt of your initial deposit, we will mail you written confirmation and a travel insurance application. Kenai Borough Tax varies based on the number in your party and the number of nights you stay with us. Seasonal fuel surcharges, when applicable, are not included in trip price and are subject to change prior to trip departure.

CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES. Trips operate rain or shine. A fee of \$100 per person is charged when arrangements are altered at the traveler’s or travel agent’s request after the written confirmation has been issued. Written cancellation must be received in our sales office in order for cancellation to be valid. Non-appearance for program will result in no refund. We highly recommend that you purchase travel insurance.

If the cancellation occurs, the per person fee is the lesser of:

121+ days prior to departure	\$200 or 10% of total
120 to 91 days	\$400 or 20% of total
90 to 36 days	50% of total
Within 35 days	100% of total

REFUNDS. Requests for refunds must be directed in writing to the agency that sold you the program. No refunds will be issued for unused services or any individual features voluntarily omitted by the participant.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Alaska Wildland Adventures reserves the right to make changes and alterations as deemed necessary for the safety and proper handling of fishing packages. Safety is a primary goal; however, outdoor activities of this nature are not entirely “risk free.” We cannot assume responsibility for injury to participants or personal belongings or for time or expense incurred. You will be required to sign an assumption of risk form. Upon advancement of deposit to Alaska Wildland Adventures, the depositor agrees to be bound by all of the above stated terms, conditions and cancellation policies whether through an agency or directly with our office. Trip dates and costs are subject to change without notice.

In the event of a cancellation or major itinerary change due to a significant natural event, Alaska Wildland Adventures will best assess the amount of available refund or credit toward a future trip with Alaska Wildland Adventures. If a trip is canceled in progress, the tour operator will best attempt to prorate a refund based on the number of days not completed. *In any case, Alaska Wildland Adventures cannot guarantee any refund amount due to cancellations beyond our control and strongly recommends all guests purchase travel insurance.*

TWO DOLLARS A DAY FOR CONSERVATION.

AWA and Kenai River Sportfishing Lodge contribute annually to Alaska-based nonprofit efforts for environmental and fisheries protection. As a consumer you can elect to participate in our “Two Dollars A Day” program by making a voluntary

contribution of \$2 per person per day of your trip with us. This amount will be added to your final invoice. If you choose, you may deduct the amount from your final payment. Donations made to this program will be equally divided among:

FISH PROCESSING AND SHIPPING. As an added value, we include fish processing in each lodge package. We will fillet, vacuum pack and freeze your fish. We provide shipping boxes and ice packs and will box your catch for airline shipment. Other custom services are available for an additional cost. Overnight express shipping is available at standard rates.

ALASKA STATE FISH AND GAME LICENSES AND BAG LIMITS.

Alaska Department of Fish and Game requires that all anglers possess fish licenses on their person at all times. Licenses are available for purchase at our lodge. This fee is not included in your package cost. Please note that State Fish and Game officials may, on occasion, place “catch and release,” modified bag limits, or temporary closures on salmon to protect their annual return. Fishing seasons and bag limits have also been known to be increased. Rainbow trout are catch and release. We strongly support regulations designed to result in the sustainability of this outstanding resource.

ALASKA WILDLAND ADVENTURES' KENAI RIVER SPORTFISHING LODGE IS USCG LICENSED AND OPERATES IN THESE PUBLIC LANDS UNDER SPECIAL USE PERMITS: the Kenai River Special Management Area; Kenai National Wildlife Refuge; Chugach National Forest; and Alaska State Parks.

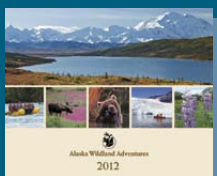
